New hotels and leisure activities to attract visitors to Northeast Germany

New hotels and leisure activities to attract visitors to Northeast Germany Unique accommodation, new hotels, and leisure activities – in the 2018 season, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern will surprise its visitors with new offers. Examples include the Upcycling Hotel in Rövershagen, which is going to open in March, the Sleeperoo, which aims at providing sustainable overnight stays at the visitors' favourite destinations, and the new Müritzpalais in the lakeland Mecklenburgische Seenplatte. Following is a selection of new offers:

Karls to open the Upcycling Hotel in Rövershagen on March 23, 2018

Spending the night comfortably amid euro-pallets, relaxing under the light of a lamp made from an old coffeepot, chatting while sitting around a cable drum table: The Upcycling Hotel "Alles Paletti", which will open on March 23 in Rövershagen near Rostock, will provide accommodation of a special kind for its guests. The opening also marks Robert Dahl's entry into the hotel business following his successful operation of three adventure villages in the Northeast and of the "Pier 7" in the seaside resort Warnemünde. The new concept is just as unique as his adventure villages which are particularly popular among families. All of the 50 rooms are equipped with materials and furniture which have a special history, and which were refurbished meticulously. For example, skis serve as edges of the bed, sledges become bathroom shelves and chairs are turned into ladders. Booking is possible starting at a price of 67 Euros for a double room including a day ticket for Karls adventure village which hotel guests can see from their rooms.

Dipping into the sea: Müritzpalais to open in Waren (Müritz) in spring 2018

The lakeland Mecklenburgische Seenplatte has a new hotel: This season, the Müritzpalais will open in Waren (Müritz) by the largest German inland lake. It is supposed to combine the benefits of a hotel with the comfort of exclusively equipped holiday apartments. The house by the lake comprises 85 hotel apartments with living areas between 45 and 100 square metres from which holidaymakers can enjoy the view on the lake Müritz and the old town of Waren. The ensemble also includes, among others, an outdoor terrace, a spa area, and a bathing jetty from which guests can dip directly into the "Little Sea", as the Müritz is sometimes called due to its size.

The "Design|sleep Cubes" concept – cubical rooms quickly and easily built with the help of a plugin arrangement – allows guests to spend a special night at unique places, both indoors and outdoors. with the Schwerin-based Langefreunde Design Studio and Greenboats from Bremen. The cosy rooms include a 1.60m-wide lying surface, blankets made from sheep's wool, reliable privacy shields and weather protection, energy-saving LED lighting, and a so-called chill pack, a selection of snacks and drinks. Holidaymakers can book the Sleeperoo for the first time at the travel trade show ITB Berlin, where Mecklenburg-Vorpommern will be the first official partner region. Former nautical college will become a holiday home

The nautical college of Wustrow on the Fischland-Darß-Zingst peninsula, which closed in 1992, is currently being refurbished. Under the slogan "Zwei Wasser" ("two waters") – a reference to the location between the Bodden and the Baltic Sea – the former school for captains, nautical officers, and radio operators will be turned into holiday apartments and apartment houses. In the lobby, there will be an exhibition on the history of the house featuring original objects. The apartments can be booked via the K&K Ferienimmobilien GmbH & Co. KG.

A new world for polar bears and the like: Polarium to open in the zoo of Rostock

The so-called Polarium is currently under construction in the zoo of Rostock. On a surface of 12,500 square metres, it is supposed to provide a species-appropriate environment for polar bears, penguins, and ocean dwellers. The new site will be designed as an adventure and educational space on the topic of the poles, giving visitors a better understanding of the animals' mode of life. The Polarium will comprise an outdoor enclosure with breeding burrows as well as a water basin and a stable for up to 36 Humboldt penguins and their offspring.

Furthermore, there will be a spacious, tundra-like landscape for three polar bears and their offspring, and a visitor centre will give insights into the water basins of the polar bears as well as into the modes of living and the anatomy of penguins and polar bears. The project is supported by the Mecklenburg-Vorpommern Ministry of Economy through the fund for the improvement of regional economic structure with a total amount of 10.26 million Euros. The total investment costs for the Polarium amount to 11.51 million Euros. The opening is scheduled for the late summer of 2018.

Holiday residence under construction in the Ohlerich Speicher in Wismar

The Bay of Wismar in the front, the Old Town in the back: The heritageprotected Ohlerich Speicher, which got its name from an old seafarer family from Warnemünde, is currently being transformed into a luxury holiday home. Upon its completion in 2018, it will offer guests holidays with a superb view. The 34-metre high building, which was built in 1938 and used to serve as a grain silo, will contain 48 holiday apartments with living spaces between 48 and 94 square metres. The ground floor will feature a large welcome area with a restaurant and a sun terrace with a view on the harbour. The project investor is the Penta Real Estate GmbH & Co. KG.

Two hundred years ago, the Greifswald-born Romantic artist Caspar David Friedrich (1774–1840) married his wife Caroline in Dresden. After the wedding, the newly married couple embarked on a honeymoon trip which lead them to his home region. During their trip, they visited, among others, Greifswald, Neubrandenburg, and the island of Rügen. Friedrich seized the opportunity to paint many of his most famous works, such as "On The Sailing Boat ", "Greifswald Market Square", and "Chalk Cliffs on Rügen". Two hundred years later, a range of events will be held in memory of this special honeymoon trip and the artist's

Vorpommern Tourist Association to designate Route of North German Romantic

The Tourist Association of Vorpommern has introduced a new bike theme route following the footsteps of Caspar David Friedrich, Philipp Otto Runge, and Friedrich August von Klinkowström. The so-called "Route of North German Romantic" runs between the towns of Wolgast and Greifswald and is ready for use from 2018 onwards. Along the route, nine information boards will document the lives and works of those three Romantic artists. The information boards were designed with the support of the Caspar-David-Friedrich-Zentrum in Greifswald. Stops along the route include Philipp Otto Runge's birth house, which was reopened on the occasion of his 240th birthday on July 23, 2017, Ludwigsburg Palace, and the parsonage in Wusterhusen. From spring 2018 onwards, guided tours with trained tour guides will be available for those who do not want to explore the route on their own. The project is financed by a EU leader project for rural areas.

Upcycling Hostel to open in Wolagst in spring

On April 21, 2018, a new destination for school and youth trips will open in Wolgast. Right next to the Postel, which won the third prize in the German Tourism Awards in 2015, an upcycling hostel – the "100Haus" – is currently in the making. With the support of a leader project, the 118year old former school building was refurbished by students of the Runge Gymnasium Wolgast and architects to become a modern, unique youth guest house. For example, book pages have been turned into wallpaper, and euro-pallets have become beds or shelves. The 17 rooms each feature between one and eight beds, and rooms suitable for

the disabled are also available. Creative areas, where guests can cook, play, or paint, as well as attractive offers with promising titles, such as "Coast, Storm, and Spring Tide" are aimed at drawing young travellers to the town located before the gates of Usedom. The name "100Haus" is a reference to Loris Malaguzzi's (1920-1994) poem "The Hundred Languages of Children". Furthermore, the house, in cooperation with the town, has the ambition to offer 100 opportunities for children and adolescents. The project operator and investor is the Postel Usedom GmbH.

Refurbished Wismar Museum shines in new splendour

At the end of 2017, the Museum of Town History in Wismar opened its exhibition in the extensively refurbished Schabbellhaus, named after Heinrich Schabbell (1531-1600), a brewer, councillor, and later mayor of the town. The exhibition illustrates the 800-year long history of the Hanseatic town on a surface of 1,200 square metres. The Hanseatic League, the time under Swedish rule, Wismar as an industrial town and during the GDR are only some of the thematic highlights of the exhibition which was designed following the principles of an inclusive model, making it accessible for people with different perceptive potentials. Moreover, visitors have the chance to listen to contemporary witnesses at audio stations. Commentary and materials are available in German and English.
